OVERVIEW

For the benefit of customers who are unable to visit the shop in Southwell, I have, to date, compiled the three catalogues listed below.

A: History and Philosophy of the Physical Sciences and Technologies

B: Social History

C: Biographies and Diaries

In future, I plan to increase the number of such catalogues for a range of subject areas. This is a fairly time-consuming process for a one-person enterprise - so the rate at which I accomplish this is likely to be slow!

But I also have specialist collections on certain subject areas (often not stocked in the shop) about which some customers seeking certain titles may wish to enquire (preferably, initially, by email), e.g.

- History of biology, agriculture and medicine (especially infant feeding in humans and dairying)
- Philosophy and theology
- Essays
- Sociology, politics and education

- **Preferably, orders should be made by email, stating your name, exact postal address and the catalogue code number/s of the item/s requested *plus* the (first) author's name. Exceptionally, you may make an order by telephone (voicemail) or surface mail.**
- **On receipt of an order, if the item/s is still available, I will send an invoice for the full amount required (dependent on postal charge etc).**
- **Preferably, payment should be made by cheque made out to Ben Mephram and posted to me at Gladstone Books, 2 Bull Yard, Southwell, Notts NG25 0EH. Please send me an email confirming that this has been done.**
- **When payment is received I shall send a email confirming this - and dispatch the items to you at the earliest opportunity.**
- **I aim to give accurate descriptions of all items, but should you not be satisfied with an item, please send me an email explaining the circumstances. You are free to return any such item, but it is requested that this be done at the earliest opportunity. On receiving it, the original net book price will be repaid promptly.**
